Kia Ora and welcome to our AGM. It is my pleasure to present this, my 15th Report on both our Newsletter and Website (^{N.B.} This report will cover a slightly longer period than usual).

T E REO – Not unexpectedly, the structure of the newsletter in both electronic and hardcopy format continues to remain consistent and there is little change to be expected at this time. I am constantly grateful to our Committee for their support and content contributions and I am also extremely grateful for contributions from our members – although these have been somewhat lacking again this year, unfortunately.

The 'Members Only' portal via the NZSG website seems to be working well and we must thank Tracy as NZSG webmaster for the prompt manner in which the newsletters are uploaded to the site.

As always, the Black & White hardcopy issues of *Te Reo* are an important and permanent record of the group's activities, although the newsletter is best viewed in full colour online through the NZSG website as pdf.

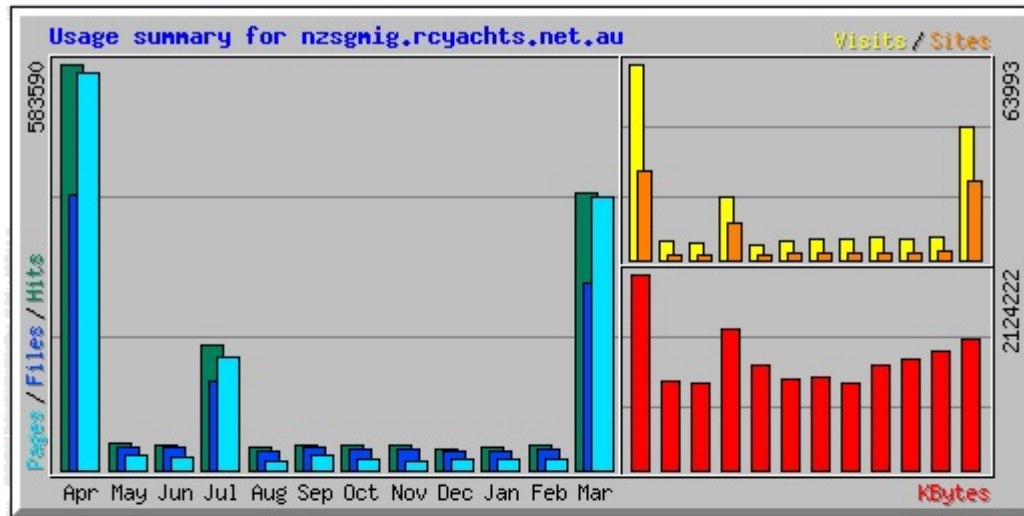

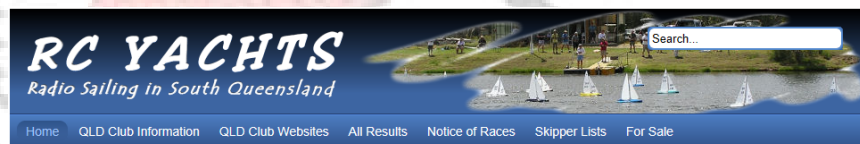
